State Library of Ohio recently awarded a \$1,600,000 federal grant for Libraries Connect Ohio to purchase online resources for the Ohio Web Library. The Ohio Web Library databases include current and historical information and resources such as full-text magazines and journals; maps; educational videos; reference and literary materials; test prep practice, tutorials and manuals; online courses; and workforce skills development, career exploration and job search tools. Notable Government Documents Awards


Four Ohio documents receive national recognition

Congratulations to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife and Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Tourism Ohio for receiving Notable Government Document 2012 awards from the American Library Association's Government Documents Round Table (GODORT). The awards were recently announced in the Library Journal article, *Notable Government Documents of 2012: Looking Back, Moving Ahead*.

The Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife received the award for *Dragonflies and Damselflies of Ohio Field Guide* and *Common Birds of Ohio: CD Guidebook* within the State/Local category.

The Development Services Agency, Office of Tourism Ohio also received the award within the State/Local category for *Fall/Winter Recreation Guide* and *Ohio's Family Fun*.

The purpose of Notable Documents is to recognize excellence in government publications and identify documents of distinction. Notable Documents are divided into the three categories: international, federal, and state/local. Documents in both electronic and paper formats are nominated by libraries and agencies throughout the country. The State Library of Ohio nominated the Ohio documents selected and will have them on display in our lobby during the summer.
