




# Electronic Journal Center Quick Start Guide

Electronic Journal Center from OhioLINK includes the full text of more than 7000 online research journals covering many subject areas.

## Four Ways to Do Research:


- Browse by Title:** The Electronic Journal Center allows you to select a letter of the alphabet and then view all of the journal titles that start with that letter.
- Search for a Journal:** The Electronic Journal Center allows you to search for a specific journal title by selecting the "Journal Title" search field from the drop down menu next to the search box.
- Search the EJC:** The same search box allows you to search the entire contents of the collection by using the keyword, author, article title, abstract search options or by using the any field search option.
- Browse by Subject:** Finally, the EJC allows you to view all of the journal titles in a given subject.



## Getting Results:

Your results list will display several key pieces of information:

- Bibliographic Information about the result with relevance ranking
- Your search terms and number of results returned
- How your results are sorted
- HELP
- MyEJC Log-in



## My EJC:

The **MyEJC** feature allows users to create a free account with the Electronic Journal Center. This account provides a space to save favorite journals, article and searches as well as to sign-up for emailed alerts when new issues of those journals are published or new articles matching those searches are released.

## Access:

The EJC can be accessed two ways. From within the State Library of Ohio and many state agency buildings using the library homepage ([www.library.ohio.gov](http://www.library.ohio.gov)) or remotely using OhioLINK.

### From the Library Homepage:

- Select "State Employee" from the menu bar across the top of the page and click "EJC" under OhioLINK resources.
- If the page is unable to authenticate you as a state employee, please follow the remote access instructions below.

### Using OhioLINK:

- From the library homepage, select "Access OhioLINK Resources" and then select "Access OhioLINK Resources from Any Other Location".
- Enter your last name and the last nine digits of your State Library of Ohio library card.
- Under "Databases Listed By Name", select the letters "D-E" and scroll down to the Electronic Journal Center.
- Select "Electronic Journal Center".
